### **THE STORY:**

*Founded in 1998, the partnership of Arger-Martucci Vineyards is more than a business venture between two owners; it is a love and appreciation of making great wine that is shared by two families ~ one Greek, the other of Italian descent. Owned and managed by the Arger's and Martucci's, the enterprise is a culmination of varied talents and expertise with one common goal: to produce limited amounts of premium, handcrafted wine.*

*Our Estate Winery is located in St. Helena, the heart of the Napa Valley, while our primary vineyards sit high atop Soda Canyon Road in the Atlas Peak District. Our Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes come from vineyards on Dealy Lane in Carneros. Kosta Arger, a well-respected cardiologist in Reno, Nevada, is a popular guest lecturer on the topic of wine and heart disease. Noted for his extraordinary palate, Dr. Arger has been making wine since 1976 after encouragement and mentoring from Joe Heitz. Over the years he has judged in numerous wine competitions and recently started a cooking show that airs locally on PBS.*

*Rich Martucci and his wife Carol came west from New York in 1978. After starting a mortgage firm, Martucci acquired a struggling bank, which he expanded into a successful, multi branch community bank. In 1998 they sold the business to nationwide Colonial Bank where Rich continues to serve on the Board of Directors while also volunteering for several non-profit community organizations. He directs the business side of the partnership.*
